**About the *CEED***

The **Catholic Endowment for Educational Development (*CEED*)** is a permanent component fund of the Washington County Community Foundation, Inc. (WCCF) created to support Catholic education at John F. Kennedy (JFK) Catholic School and the Total Catholic Education (TCE) program at Immaculate Conception Church.

**About the WCCF**

The WCCF is a 501(c) (3) publicly supported not-for-profit corporation headquartered in Washington, PA. It is governed by a volunteer Board of Trustees and has been found compliant with the National Standards for Community Foundations. Having received its first endowed fund in December 1995, the WCCF currently manages over 100 permanent funds with a combined value of approximately \$5 million.

***CEED* Board of Directors**

A separate Board of Directors, comprised of representatives of JFK and the TCE program, has been established to monitor the annual grants from the *CEED*.

**Grants from the *CEED***

Annual grants will be issued by the WCCF. The specific uses of the grants shall be determined by the *CEED* Board of Directors, which shall adhere, within a deviation of 10%, to the following percentages:

- 40% for scholarships at JFK
- 30% for operating expenses at JFK
- 10% for educational materials at JFK
- 10% for educational materials at TCE
- 10% for building enhancements utilized by JFK and TCE

**Investment of Assets**

Assets of the *CEED* are invested by the WCCF in sound investments which adhere to the Christian values and teachings of the Catholic Church.
