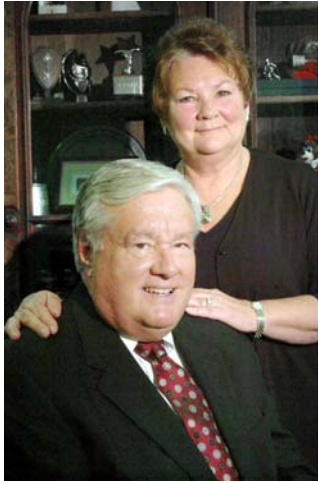


John A. & Barbara L. Campbell Fund
