for Burgettstown High School Graduating Seniors

Normally, one \$500 scholarship is awarded each year.

Requirements:

- Applicant must be a current year graduating senior from Burgettstown High School
- Applicant must demonstrate ability to complete chosen post-secondary course of study.
- Applicant must be accepted at a post secondary school of education for the fall after graduation. There is no requirement as to the type of school or years of study.
- Applicant must provide high school transcript and have maintained at least a 3.0 grade point average since the ninth grade.
- Applicant must provide a copy of the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
- Applicant must provide an essay of no more than 500 words regarding past accomplishments and future goals including community service activities.
- Applicant must provide two letters of recommendation (no relatives please).
- Applicant must complete application form as provided. Submissions with “see attached” written on the application form cannot be considered, nor will any supplemental material.

Application must be received by the Foundation by April 1st
Scholarship will be awarded in the spring
