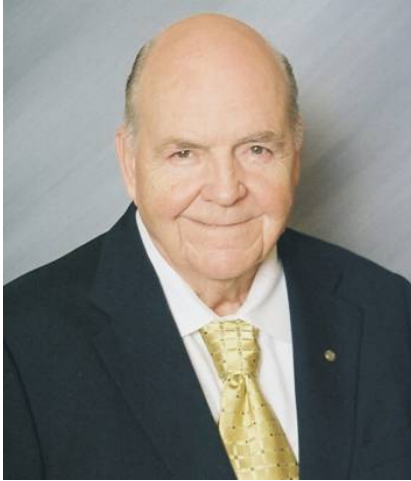


**Malcolm L. Morgan**
