EACH YEAR WE AWARD SOME GRANTS FROM DISCRETIONARY RESOURCES, THROUGH AN OPEN AND COMPETITIVE PROCESS THAT SEEKS TO ADDRESS THE CHANGING AND UNMET NEEDS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY. IN ADDITION TO GRANT-MAKING FUNDS WHOSE SPECIFIC CHARITABLE PURPOSES WERE DEFINED BY THE DONORS AT THE TIME THE FUNDS WERE CREATED, THE FOUNDATION ALSO MANAGES THREE PERMANENT POOLED GRANT-MAKING FUNDS, WITH CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED BY MULTIPLE DONORS WHO SHARE A COMMON CHARITABLE INTEREST.
