

OFFICIAL RULES: WCCF SILVER ANNIVERSARY MARCH MADNESS BASKETBALL BRACKET CONTEST

No purchase necessary.

Contest period is March 15-April 6, 2020.

You must be at least thirteen (13) years at the time of entry to be eligible for this contest. This contest is void where prohibited by law.

There will be one winner for the Washington County Community Foundation (WCCF) Silver Anniversary March Madness Basketball Bracket contest as determined by the computerized 2020 CBSSports.com Bracket Manager (“2020 Bracket Manager”), provided by CBS Interactive Inc. (CBSI). The 2020 Bracket Manager is subject to the 2020 Bracket Manager Terms of Use, which may be accessed at <http://www.cbssports.com/info/about/tos/bm> and updated by CBSI periodically without notice.

If you are a wireless service subscriber and have a smartphone, tablet, or wireless device that allows you to access this 2020 Bracket Manager product, you may use this 2020 Bracket Manager via any of those devices. If you choose to participate via any such wireless devices, you may be charged data rates in accordance with the Terms and Conditions of the wireless Service Agreement with your wireless carrier.

As the winner of the WCCF Silver Anniversary March Madness Basketball Bracket contest, the individual, who will be selected based on the highest number of points (please see bracket scoring below), will have the opportunity to designate one unrestricted grant of \$2,500 to a registered nonprofit that provides at least one charitable program in Washington County, Pennsylvania. The grant will be issued from the WCCF’s *Acorn Fund*.

The winner will be notified by email on Tuesday, April 7, 2020; therefore, the email address used for registration must be valid. If a winner is unreachable by email after 48 hours, or if that winner is unavailable for prize fulfillment, an alternate winner will be selected based on the second-highest number of points received in the bracket contest.

Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.

Each participant must complete the registration process through the 2020 Bracket Manager and enter the Washington County Community Foundation pool by the start of Round 1. Brackets open on the evening of Sunday, March 15, 2020, immediately following the NCAA tournament *Selection Sunday* show (broadcast on CBS at 6 p.m. ET). Players are able to enter the Washington County Community Foundation pool until tip-off time of the first game of the tournament on Thursday, March 19, 2020.

Brackets will be scored as follows:

- Round 1 / March 19-20 – One (1) point for each correct pick
- Round 2 / March 21-22 – Two (2) points for each correct pick
- Sweet 16 / March 26-27 – Four (4) points for each correct pick
- Elite Eight / March 28-29 – Eight (8) points for each correct pick
- Final Four / April 4 – Sixteen (16) points for each correct pick
- National Championship / April 6 – Thirty-two (32) points for each correct pick

The WCCF reserves the right to, and may or may not, monitor/screen entries.

Employees of WCCF, members of its Board of Trustees, and their immediate family members (as defined as spouses/partners, parents, children, and siblings) are not eligible to win.
